#### **Mammography APs: Discuss topics that matter to you**

#### **New AI tools for breast screening services**

Software to help mammography services run more efficiently and to check mammograms are being developed by companies working with NHS partners.

#### **IT needs 'radical upgrade' to improve cancer screening, interim report finds**

IT needs to be "radically upgraded" and online booking needs to be introduced to improve cancer screening programmes in the NHS, an interim report has found.

#### **Learning from the Macmillan Local Authority Partnership Programme**

A guide has been issued which focuses on implementing system change in cancer care by drawing on the experience of the Macmillan Local Authority Partnership Programme (MLAPP). The guide supports leaders, commissioners and practitioners from health, social care, housing and voluntary and community sector organisations to implement a person-centred, integrated approach to providing care and support to people living with cancer and other long-term conditions (LTCs).


### Review of national cancer screening programmes in England

Radiotherapy equipment has been replaced or upgraded in 38 cancer centres following a successful partnership between NHS England and NHS Supply Chain.
